

## Theological Scholarships

Seventh Reformed Church, Grand Rapids, Michigan, USA ([www.7thref.org](http://www.7thref.org)) has long been committed to supporting seminary education. That support is now funneled directly to theological students pursuing pastoral ministry. Consistent with the mission of the Church, the support is available to students training globally, and amounts to three scholarships of \$3000.00 each.

To qualify for one of the scholarships, applicants must be:

1. A communicant member in good standing of the Christian church, and in a body of believers in membership of the World Reformed Fellowship or in a clearly recognizable Reformed equivalent.
2. A male enrolled at a conservative Reformed theological college or seminary, and able to affirm sincerely the Three Forms of Unity and/or the Westminster Standards, and the World Reformed Fellowship Statement of Faith.
3. On a degree track geared to pastoral ministry (e.g., M.Div., pastoral track).
4. Recommended by both a pastoral and an academic referee. The pastoral referee writes in support of character and general suitability to pastoral ministry, and the academic reference in support of achievements and overall impression in seminary training.

Please note:

1. This scholarship offer is STRICTLY for individuals meeting the criteria. Only queries from individuals who are themselves personally applying for scholarships will be processed.
2. For any scholarship application to be considered, it must include all of the information requested. Applications will be processed only when all of the required information is received.

To apply for the scholarship, applicants must provide:

1. A completed application form (replete with the assurances and recommendations listed above).
2. A short bio.
3. A promise of, at least, an annual report to the Consistory of how the studies have gone, in the event of a successful application.

Those receiving a scholarship, will be:

1. Invited to visit Seventh Reformed Church during the period in which the support is effective.
2. Eligible to undertake an internship at Seventh Reformed Church, when feasible.
3. Eligible to apply for a continuation of the scholarship.
