Religion and the Heart of Man James 1:26–27

Introduction: True religion and worship come from a pure heart that is set on the Word of God and filled with His grace.

- 1) Worthless Religion (v. 26)
 - a. Worthless religion focuses on outward appearance but neglects the heart.

- 2) Pure Religion (v. 27)
 - a. Pure and undefiled religion encompasses both a love for people and a hatred of sin.
- 3) True Religion (vv. 26–27)
 - a. True religion comes from true faith and always produces the fruit of righteousness in both our speech and conduct.

Application: There are many ways to worship God in vain, through our own external religious efforts. But James says that all true religion and worship comes from a heart that is set on the Lord and seeks to do His will in all that we say and in all that we do!
